

RunLawrence Club Meeting Minutes

Sun, November 7th, 2021

Meeting held at Sunflower Bike and Outdoor Shop.

The meeting was called to order by President Kara.

The October minutes were reviewed and unanimously approved.

Treasurer Gene gave a detailed report on month's income, consisting of T-Day run registrations, membership dues, shirt & cap sales and equipment rental. Various expenses including caps for the T-Day give-away, various printing costs, race day street barricade rental, music license fee, and costs of printing and mailing neighborhood notification postcards were itemized.

It was reported that race registrations are coming in at a normal rate. Gene also announced that due a change made by the Kansas Legislature, race entries are now subject to sales tax. The registration company we use, Chronotrack, will take care of collecting and submitting that tax for us.

We decided to go with cups of water at the aid station. We will have coolers full of water and paper cups available at the start. Some bottled water will also be available. We are seeking a volunteer to set up and take down recycling containers for plastic bottles. These containers can be borrowed from the city.

We will provide bottles of hand sanitizer to be placed by any keyboards that the runners will use.

We will try to have wax paper bags available to put the cookies in individually and we may meet a couple days prior to put all the cookies in bags. Will use plastic bags if paper bags are too costly.

A couple runners reported on races they just attended which were pretty much run normally with few Covid related changes.

Anyone interested in going to the RRCA convention in Orlando in the spring was asked to make their interest known as we do want to send a couple club members.

Janet Huchingson, the club librarian, displayed a half dozen or so running related books and some were checked out by those present.
