- Income has been received from apparel sales, the first entry to the Turkey Day Run, clock rental for a time trial by Lawrence High School. Expenses were incurred to Hog Wild for the club picnic, the annual fee for website hosting and card for Turkey Day flyers.
- Profit for the River Rat 4 mile race was \$69.

### Turkey Day 5K

- Gene encouraged a discussion on potential covid related concerns for the event.

  - Level 1: Normal
  - Level 2: Normal + masks to be trashed at start
  - Level 3: Masks, social distancing and wave start.
  - Level 4: Virtual
- Current entry level stands at 11 (vs 30 at the same time point in normal average year)
- Gene shared requirements for volunteers and it was agreed that an email be sent to previous year's volunteers to seek repeat interest.

### Other Business

- Gratitude expressed to John Frydman for the facilitation of the club picnic at the Lake View Club house, which was agreed as being a great venue for the event.
