

RunLawrence Club Meeting Minutes Sun, Dec 11th, 2022

Meeting held at Sunflower Bikes.

The November minutes were reviewed and unanimously approved.

Treasury Report

- Income has been received for TDR entries, sponsorship and voluntary donations which yielded \$369, for the first time this option had been offered. Additional income came from new members and merchandise sales.

T- Day 5K

- Gene shared the budget sheet for the event, which included the 931 entries from 32 different states and countries. It is possible to make all the usual donations. Barricades and portajohns were more expensive this year, but cost was accepted as inflationary. We are awaiting charges for chocolate milk.
- Dee explained the issue with the first female runner, who ran with her father's bib. This caused problems with the downstream issuing of prizes, but was ultimately resolved.
- The issue of the time it takes for the slowest walkers to finish was discussed. It was concluded that no action was required on this.
- There was no negativity detected towards the candle gift.
- Doug Hewitt delivered candles to all sponsors, a gesture that was well received.
- Other debrief issues included:
 - RRCA membership is due for renewal to secure insurance for next year's event.
 - No promo rack cards were printed this year; instead approx. 50 handbills were printed.
 - Internet speed at Woodlawn was a temporary problem, but was ultimately resolved.
 - Matt discussed benefits of dynamic packet pick up. It was concluded that both methods have advantages and disadvantages, but that the runLawrence event would proceed as normal for now.

Other Business

- Kansas Relays 5K with start and finish at the track, April 16th. It was unanimously agreed that this would be a great event for runLawrence to get involved with and will be discussed further at the next meeting.

Meeting adjourned at 5pm. Next meeting is scheduled for 8^h January, at 4pm, Sunflower Bikes.
