

Minutes: Nov 2, 2025 runLawrence Club Meeting (Sunflower Outdoor & Bike)

The October meeting minutes were reviewed. Becky moved to approve, John seconded, passed unanimously.

Gene gave the T-Day financial report which consisted of several t-day run expenses: printing, payment for stocking caps (swag), medal ribbons, neighborhood notifications and flyers. Income included T-Day entries and sponsorship money. He indicated entries for the run are coming in normally and expects an average turnout of 1,000 plus. We need to make double sure we are not giving the swag item to those who indicated on their entry that they did not want one, nor to anyone who registers after we have hit the stated limit of entries. Heather moved to accept this report and Dee seconded, unanimously approved.

It was announced that we have secured a singer for the National Anthem from the KU Music department. Gene said many of the volunteer positions are now filled; however, there are a few left. Be sure to check the volunteer sign up page on the website.

The neighborhood notification flyers and postcards are ready and will be sent out or distributed shortly before the event.

There was a discussion as to a change of leadership for the T-Day run in 2026. The present directors are ready to retire. There was interest expressed by some of those present. More discussion will be held on this after this year's event.

Doug gave an update on the club's "Unmistakable Lawrence Event" grant application. It is mostly finished and will be submitted in the next few days. Thanks to everyone who worked on that.

It was noted that the club received a request from the USD 497 for some guidance on hosting a staff team building run/walk event in December. Molly volunteered to contact them and give some guidance.

The next meeting was set for Sunday, December 7 at 4:00 p.m. at Sunflower Outdoor.
